**ADMINISTRATION – Marsha Hall**

- Legislation

Water Service Agreement with Columbus (3<sup>rd</sup> reading) – Third reading of the ordinance was postponed until the November 24 Council meeting. The draft agreement was received on October 22 and is being reviewed by the Law Director, Engineer and myself.

Performance Evaluations (3<sup>rd</sup> reading) – Recommended by Council at the Oct. 22 COTW meeting.

2015 Health Services Contract with District Advisory Council of the Franklin County General Health District (3<sup>rd</sup> reading) – Recommended by Council at the Oct. 22 COTW meeting.

2015 Appropriations (3<sup>rd</sup> reading) – Recommended by Council with no modifications at the Oct. 22 COTW meeting. Again, on behalf of the staff and I, thank you for your attendance at the budget workshop. We believe 2015 will be an exciting, but extremely busy, year, with several important projects scheduled for completion.

We have several pieces of legislation related to the 2015 Appropriations being introduced at tonight’s meeting for first reading. I will provide additional explanations for each specific ordinance in my report for the Nov. 17 Committee of the Whole meeting.

- Medical Insurance Renewal

As I earlier reported, Medical Mutual’s initial renewal increase came in at 15%. After some negotiations, their final renewal came in at 8.6%. The new monthly premiums will be \$630 for single coverage and \$1,986 for family coverage. Using the 10% rule, an employee will be responsible for \$63 monthly (or \$29.08 per pay) for single coverage and \$198.60 monthly (or \$91.66 per pay) for family coverage. Our employees are currently responsible for \$23.69 for single coverage and \$74.73 for family per pay. This is a per pay increase of \$5.39 for single coverage and \$16.93 for family coverage. We believe this is a fair increase for the employees.
