- Brush removal program – removed 12 loads of brush and disposed at recycling facility
- Community Events – Memorial Day ceremony and banner installation
- Director meetings
 - Council Chambers audio / visual renovation meeting
 - Pickleball court maintenance discussion
 - Preliminary building design discussions for Public Service
 - Seasonal interviews
 - Wirt Rd realignment progress meeting
- Facilities maintenance
 - Aquatic Center pool preparations in progress, including circulation pump replacement
 - Golf Course roof replacement project started

- Groveport Park – pond aeration fountains installed
- Landscaping
 - Approximately 3,900 annual flowers were planted at city properties and entry features
 - Landscape irrigation was activated and calibrated

 - In partnership with Clarke Mosquito Control, hosted two equipment calibration events at Public Services to calibrate mosquito spray equipment for regional government agencies
- OUPS 811 Service – located city infrastructure for 128 tickets

- Professional development
 - 3 Department staff attended the Annual Tree City Awards Banquet in Springfield, OH
 - Department staff were trained in the safe operation of the newly purchased backhoe
- Sanitary operations
 - 5,068' of sewer line cleaned and video inspected
 - 2 manholes raised to grade
 - 31 sewer lids replaced
