Right of Way Easement Agreement with Groveport-Madison Schools 1st Reading)

This is an agreement for a right-of-way easement we need with the school for our Hendron Road project. The school has already agreed to the easement. We are requesting three readings for this emergency legislation tonight.

Authorize Administrator to Enter into an Agreement with Franklin County Engineers for the Hendron Road Project (1st Reading)

Franklin County has agreed to share in the cost of this project for the portion of roadway that is a county road. We are requesting three readings for this emergency legislation tonight.

Grant a Deed of Property for 384 Westport Drive (1st Reading)

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This is the house on Westport that had burned down. The bank has agreed to take possession of the property in order to have the property go through the Franklin County Landbank process. The City will take possession of the property from the bank, then turn it over to the landbank. The landbank will have the remaining garage removed, clean up the property, forgive the property taxes, then turn the property back over to the City. We can then sell the property to reimburse us for the cost of demolishing the house. We are requesting three readings of this emergency legislation.
