- Legislation

Five Year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) (Third Reading):

A resolution adopting the Five Year CIP for the upcoming five year period. We have included several projects that are part of the previous CIPs. In addition, we have included a few major additions. The most evident addition is the inclusion of an annual street maintenance program.

OPWC Applications (Second Readings):

Legislation for two applications for Ohio Public Works Commission funding; the Hendron Road Reconstruction Project that includes a waterline and sidewalks and a re-submission of last year's application, the West Bixby Road Pavement Rehabilitation Project.
