### **Administrative items**

### - All ages/abilities park

Christine Boucher, on behalf of the Kiwanis Club, will attend the October 26<sup>th</sup> Council meeting to present a proposal for an all ages/abilities park. The Kiwanis Club would handle fundraising, planning and construction of the park. The park would provide recreation opportunities for all ages and abilities. A similar parks was constructed in Lancaster in 2019 thru the efforts of the Lancaster Kiwanis Club.

# Vacation carryover and payout

During the November 9<sup>th</sup> Council meeting, a motion will be requested to permit employees to carryover more vacation time than is permitted by our Personnel Policy. The motion will also include a request to payout, up to 40 hours, of vacation time to employees who have accrued vacation hours in excess of the amount permitted to be carried over by policy. The motion will permit employees to carryover up to an additional 80 hours of vacation above the permitted carryover amount. The additional hours must be used by June 30, 2021 or the time will be forfeited. The payouts will be for an amount up to 40 hours in excess of the permitted carryover amount.
