- 6/2- Chair Volleyball Game at the City of Whitehall Senior Center: Each month Groveport Senior Center and the Whitehall Senior Center play Chair Volleyball together on the first Tuesday of each month. - 6/5- Lunch Munchers out to lunch trip: Our out to lunch trip in June was to the MCL Cafeteria in Upper Arlington. This is the last location for MCL in Central Ohio. Dining at the MCL is a trip down memory lane.
