

RECREATION AND OUTDOOR AQUATIC CENTER REPORT TO COUNCIL September 13, 2022 DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES – September 2022

Youth Volleyball League:

 We started our first youth Volleyball league in partnership with the Groveport Youth Athletic Association. This league runs on Monday and Friday nights from 6p-8p until November 14th. We had 80 participants register for this league.

• Fitness Floor Consultation:

• We met with two companies in September who gave us recommendations on how to improve the lower and upper fitness floors. They provided us with 3D digital renderings of how we could better layout the fitness floors, projected life of existing equipment, recommendations on new equipment, and recommendations of equipment we should replace and/or remove. These recommendations were added into the 2023 recreation budget.

• Cruiser Classic Pickleball Tournament:

• We hosted our first annual Cruiser Classic Pickleball tournament on September 24th and 25th. This tournament helped to benefit the Groveport Madison Human Needs Sports Solution Scholarship. This scholarship assists children who need help with youth registration costs. We had 40 participants in this tournament.
