

## FACILITIES and PARKS STATUS

July 21, 2014

- Several requests from the Town Hall regarding fire protection, surveillance cameras, doors and HVAC issues. Some of the issues are flood related and some are results of the upgrades made by the energy audit project. None of the items are major and can be expected with a building that requires a lot of TLC.
- An assessment was done of the City ponds and water retention areas. We looked at the signage regarding swimming, fishing and hours of operation. New signs have been ordered and will be installed ASAP. (Still waiting on signs should be any day now).
- Work continues on the new mechanical maintenance agreement at the Rec Center. The contract includes preventative maintenance on all pumps, motors and HVAC systems. All scheduling and maintenance records will be inputted into the new FMx system.
- The energy audit project continues with work near completion in the Municipal Building, Town Hall, and the Golf Course. Public Works Building is complete. Work at the Rec Center will begin the last week of July with completion by August 10<sup>th</sup>.
- The Parks Department has caught up with the grass. Work continues on the sports fields and we are working with the Rec Department to plan the Fall sports programs.
- Working with all departments that store items in the building at 605 Cherry St. building will be demolished this Autumn.
