Groveport Safety Town: March 23 – 27

Community Affairs and the Groveport Police Department are partnering with Madison Township Fire and the Franklin County Sheriff's Office to host an indoor Safety Town experience for Groveport Elementary Kindergarten and 1st grade classes. Students will take field trips to Town Hall during the last week of March to participate.

Each class will be split into three groups and rotate through three stations during a one-hour session (20 minutes per station):

- **Station 1: Mock Town & Bike Safety** – Students will navigate a mock town on balance bikes under the guidance of the Groveport Police Department.
- **Station 2: Fire Safety** – A fire safety demonstration and coordinated activity led by Madison Township Fire.
- **Station 3: Dog Safety** – A dog safety presentation with a Franklin County Sheriff's Office K-9 officer and a Columbus Police Department therapy dog.

The Groveport Quilting Club has generously volunteered their time and talents to create four structures for the mock town (such as a vet's office, grocery store, coffee shop, and flower shop).
