

## FACILITIES and PARKS STATUS

- Town Hall is now open for business, we still have a few maintenance issues with some ceiling repairs on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor and issues with the fire and camera systems. Everything looks good and it is good to have the facility operational.
- The Building Department is open in its new location in the Municipal Building. Work continues in the area that will be the Law Department and the City Engineers office.
- The Energy Audit Project continues with building management systems being installed in the MB, Golf Course and Town Hall. Lighting upgrades are scheduled for the MB, Town Hall, Public Works and the outside pool to begin May 19<sup>th</sup>.
- The Parks Department is keeping up with the Spring schedule. The ball diamonds and soccer fields are ready for use. All mowing equipment is serviced and ready to be put into action. A nice article was written in the local newspaper about the very talented group of guys that make up the Parks Department.
- An assessment was done of the City ponds and water retention areas. We looked at the signage regarding swimming, fishing and hours of operation.
- We have started a new mechanical maintenance agreement at the Rec Center. The contract includes preventative maintenance on all pumps, motors and HVAC systems. All scheduling and maintenance records will be inputted into the new FMx system.
