Legislation

No Smoking on Golf Course Club House Patio and Outdoor Seating Area (3rd Reading)

This restriction was passed by motion at the last Council meeting. It was discussed that our laws prohibit smoking within 25 feet of the building. Our current codified ordinance is general in nature and requires us to follow state laws. However, the state law prohibits smoking within 25 feet of a doorway, not the building. This legislation will clean up our current codified ordinance as well as include the restrictions passed by Council at your last meeting so that all restrictions are codified.

Tom Walker and Scott Heimlich have reviewed a few options. One or both will be in attendance to discuss their preferred option. If a decision is made at this meeting changing the current rules, I would request that emergency language be added to the legislation so that changes can be immediate since this is the primary golfing season.

Prepare and Submit an Application to OPWC for the Major Traffic Signal Upgrade – Hamilton Road at Fire House Lane and Execute All Associated Contracts (2nd Reading)

As part of their high school project, the G-M School will be asking for a school zone and has requested improving the traffic signal heads and installing a crosswalk and sidewalk from the school to the COTA stop across the street. We also have a project for future consideration on our Capital Improvement Plan to upgrade the signals with a mast arm signal. Our Engineer believes combining these two projects would make an excellent grant application to OPWC, considering the cooperation with the school and safety issues. This funding application will include local match by both the City and the school, and save both of us several thousands of dollars.

Prepare and Submit an Application to OPWC for the West Bixby Road Rehabilitation Phase II Project and Execute All Associated Contracts (2nd Reading)

This project would be the 2nd phase of a three phase project to upgrade West Bixby Road, following this year's Phase I grant project.

Resolution Adopting the Five Year Capital Improvement Plan (2nd Reading)

Adoption of this plan is necessary for submittal of the two funding applications to OPWC.

Resolution to Continue to Participate in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program (1st Reading)

This will enable us to continue to participate in this program for a three year period beginning April 1, 2018. We just received the information and the county needs the information back asap so I have requested emergency language and ask that Council consider passage at tonight's meeting.
