Proclaiming Groveport-Madison Lions Club as Grand Marshall for the City of Groveport's 4th of July Celebration

The City of Groveport acknowledges the Groveport-Madison Lions Club for 75 years of service to the community; and

Over the years the club has accomplished many things; they purchased and installed the first street signs and planted trees on both side of Main Street; and

WHEREAS:

In conjunction with Boy Scout Troop #71, which the Lions Club sponsors, all the houses in Groveport were numbered; and

WHEREAS:

the Lions Club purchased and installed the original Christmas lights over and along Main Street for many years; originated the Halloween Parade and festivities and still sponsors the Halloween Block Party; and

WHEREAS:

the Lions Club for several years organized the Fourth of July Parade; purchased and installed the plaque and stone at Groveport Elementary School honoring the Second World War Veterans; and

WHEREAS:

Presently the club pays for testing and eyeglasses for children in the community, as well as contributes to many organizations and supports the Greater Groveport Human Needs and Greater Groveport Food Pantry.
