The center (facility) remains closed.

The Groveport Senior Center Board was unable to meet in person. President, Theresa Kaza, made calls to the board members to discuss the business at hand. The board voted that current members (2020) will not be charged for dues in 2021.

We hosted 2 drive thru events for our members. The first took place on November 24th. This was sponsored by Brookdale Senior Living. Members received a Thanksgiving pie, a calendar and some received a turkey sponsored by a local Groveport business. We served 80 thankful people at the pie drive thru.

The second drive thru event took place on December 18th. The event was sponsored by Violet Springs Health Campus. The members received boxes of Christmas treats prepared by their chef. We treated 100 people at the Christmas treat drive thru. Participants were thrilled to receive their treats, get out of the house and see some familiar faces!

Our next drive thru is a "Souper Bowl" event scheduled for February 5th. It will be sponsored by Wesley Ridge Senior Living. The members will receive soup, cornbread and a dessert that will be prepared by the chef at Wesley Ridge. We're encouraging participants to wear their favorite team colors! We anticipate serving 100 people for this event.

We partnered with Wesley Ridge Retirement Village to offer a virtual craft of the month via Zoom. Wesley Ridge is providing all supplies for the craft. Members will stop by the center to pick them up prior to the Zoom event on the 4th Friday of each month. The first event is scheduled for Friday January 22nd. We will be making coffee filter wreaths.

We are using Civic Ready and Facebook as our means of communication with the membership. Our members are engaging with us on the Facebook page. 101 people "like" our page so far.

We are staying in close contact with State, County and local agencies in order to continue to make the best decisions for a safe re-opening of our center.
