- Legislation  
Preliminary Consent Legislation for US-33 resurfacing project – no cost to City; a very short portion of US-33 is within our corporation boundaries so we need to give this project our blessing. The signed legislation must be returned to ODOT by March 31.
  
- Mayor’s Court Registration  
You may have received information from the Ohio Municipal League of the need to register Mayor’s Court. This has been done.
  
- Green Light Project  
The Green Light Project which was highlighted on our website and in a recent proclamation by Mayor Westcamp will occur between January 10 and January 31. Representatives from Madison Christian Church will be placing green ribbons on the Main Street lamp posts to provide focus on this project.
  
- Changes to Merit Increase System  
I have scheduled meetings with each department to be held this week to review the new merit increase system procedures with the employees. The Department Heads will then be meeting with each employee who received a criteria rating score of 2 (meets) or below on any criteria to discuss with the employee how that person can improve his or her score.
  
- Senior Transportation Vehicle Grant  
We have been informed that we are no longer eligible to participate in ODOT’s Federal Specialized Transportation Program for funding for our Senior Transportation vehicles. We are now included in the “Large Urban” category (which includes any entity within Franklin County), and the monies will be administered through MORPC. MORPC is currently working on a plan of how to expend these funds, but they did indicate that grant opportunities through this program may be considerably different than in the past. We will make you aware of what this means to us financially as we become aware.
