<u>Railroad Lines</u>

According to Rep. Bishoff's office a study has been approved by the Ohio Rail Development Commission which would upgrade the entire Columbus to Lancaster to Logan line. The studied improvements would upgrade the line from a Class I (9 mph) to a Class 2 (25 mph) rail. They believe this will help to alleviate truck traffic on SR33. Rep. Bishoff will keep us informed regarding this.
