RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The Groveport 4th of July Committee, the Groveport Madison Schools who stage the parade, and/or the Groveport Police Department reserve the right to reject any entry either before, during or after the parade that does not abide by the rules and regulations and/or the true purpose and spirit of the Independence Day celebration.

The following rules and regulations are in place to assure the enjoyment and safety for both participants and the viewing public. The following rules and regulations will be strictly enforced.

1. **CANDY**, souvenirs, or any other items may **NOT** be thrown due to the danger of children running into the street or viewers being struck in the eye. All items to be given away **must be handed** to the crowd by walkers near the curb off to the side of the vehicle or float.
2. Water guns, “super-soakers” and water balloons are strictly prohibited.
3. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the staging area or along the parade route.
4. Automobiles not officially entered in the parade are not permitted in the parade staging area.
5. All entries that include children must have an adequate number of adult leaders to supervise.
6. State law prohibits riding to and from the parade on a float.
7. All motorized vehicles must be operated by licensed/insured drivers.
8. Entries may not exit parade route before the end of the parade. Entries must follow the direction of the police officers and/or parade officials directing them to the end of the parade.
9. Parade officials will inspect all entries and reserve the right to eliminate any entry that is in violation of these rules.
10. Entries may be prohibited from future parades if rules are not followed.
