GREAT celebrated its 1st birthday on September 28th. In the first year GREAT shuttles:

- √ travelled over 93,800 miles
- ✓ provided 23,520 safe rides to and from work
  - ❖ GREAT provided 191 rides in the 1st week
  - Single week high of 749 rides
  - ❖ 52 week average of 452 rides per week
- √ increased shuttle stops and service times to better serve employees and employers
- √ are serving 60+ employers
