2016 is behind us and we are very excited for what new programs/classes will be offered in 2017.

Stop in anytime to see the Art work of Rebecca Jadway in Town Hall's Art Gallery January 4 – 29 and admire the work of Rebecca Jadway. Her exhibit features, miniatures, along with x-rays of insects and other animals and fairies. The miniature rooms are made from wood, foam core, mate board and found objects. The dolls are LA Doll clay and air dry clay that is painted with acrylics and gel medium, and the food is made from clay, dried acrylic paint and gel, stained glass paint, and plated on buttons. The rooms and dolls are anime-inspired, some are traditional 1/12 scale dollhouse, dolls, and accessories. A lot of the art is 2-D and 3-D, figurative, in various levels of realism.
