The number of unique riders served in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter increased to 71. We are very pleased to have exceeded our goals in 2016 while providing excellent customer service. Our goal was to serve 90 unique riders for the year and we surpassed that number with a total of 98 unique riders. According to our survey that was conducted in September of 2016, 100% of the 133 clients we contacted agreed that Groveport Senior Transportation provides options that enhance their ability to remain healthy and live independently. We have signed up several new clients to the program in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter. It is rewarding to be able to serve new clients in order to strengthen our community and help older adults live independently in their homes longer. It is our privilege to continue to serve the residents of the City of Groveport.
