Legislation

Prohibiting animals in established designated areas for certain City sponsored or City supported events (2nd Reading)

This will provide enforcement capabilities to prohibit animals from City sponsored or supported events and festival areas.

Moratorium for One Year on the Issuance of Permits allowing Dispensaries, Cultivators or Processors of Medical Marijuana (3rd Reading)

The rules are currently being adopted by the Ohio Medical Marijuana Control Program. Cultivator rules are required by the law to be adopted by May 6 and all other rules are to be adopted by September 8. A one-year moratorium will allow us to review all of the adopted rules and make a determination as to whether to limit or prohibit them and to set any City specific regulations.

Retirement and Re-Appointment to Same Position (3rd Reading)

This provides procedures for employees who are eligible for retirement and who wish to be re-appointed to their same position.

Elected Official Salary and Benefit Changes (3rd Reading)

We have prepared two pieces of legislation making changes to Council and Mayor salaries and benefits at the request of the Council President Pro Tem. The legislation pertaining to Council compensation will be modified at the recommendation of Council to provide a life insurance policy of one times the salary instead of \$3,000.
