Legislation

Conveyance of Utility Easements to Columbia Gas Transmission LLC (1st Reading)

This authorizes the Administrator to convey four (4) utility easements to Columbia Gas Transmission LLC for their upcoming transmission line replacement project. Included in that will be the execution of four supplemental agreements which details the both the company's responsibilities and the City's expectations.

This will be our normal process of presenting the tax budget for submittal to Franklin County.

Miscellaneous

Farmers Market

Stephen Moore was approached by Sophie's Gourmet Pierogis to be able to set up in the parking lot during the market on Tuesdays. The zoning district does not permit food trucks. Stephen suggested that this be considered by a motion vote by Council to allow this on a temporary basis during the market season. This would be very similar to Council's vote to allow temporary employment signage in the industrial area last year. One thing to consider is to restrict the number allowed. The parking lot was more than ½ filled during the first market.

Ethics Training

We have scheduled Ethics training for August 21st from 5:00pm to 6:30pm. The Committee of the Whole meeting will begin at 6:30pm.

Pelotonia

As usual, we have signed a contract with Pelotonia for use of the Cruiser Park parking lot for a stop along their route on August 5. Their route enters Groveport along West Bixby Road, which will be under construction this Summer. We have scheduled the project so that it should be completed by July 28. Should an unplanned problem such as weather cause a delay with the project, we have met with Pelotonia and the police department to develop an alternate route.

MetroParks Plans

Steve Farst, Tom Byrne and I met with MetroParks to discuss their long term plans to connect Walnut Woods trails to ours in Groveport Park. We also discussed other possible connections between City paths to MetroParks facilities.
