National Police Week is to honor the service and sacrifice of the law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty while protecting our communities; and

WHEREAS:

there are approximately 900,000 law enforcement officers serving in communities across the United States, including the dedicated members of the Groveport Police Department; and

WHEREAS:

in 2017, 129 Peace Officers died in the line of duty nationwide, five of those Peace Officers died in the line of duty in Ohio; and

WHEREAS:

there have been more than 21,000 names added to the Memorial Wall in Washington D.C.; and

WHEREAS:

this administration joins in this special tribute to acknowledge all Ohio officers who have given the supreme sacrifice -their livesin defense of the citizens of Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LANCE WESTCAMP, Mayor of the City of Groveport, Ohio, do hereby proclaim:

MAY 13 through MAY 19, 2018 AS NATIONAL POLICE WEEK and MAY 15, 2018 AS NATIONAL PEACE OFFICERS' MEMORIAL DAY

in memory and respect of those officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty. I do hereby declare that all flags are to fly at half-staff on May 15, 2018, throughout the City of Groveport.
