Engineering Department – *Steve Farst*

- **Capital Projects:**

Alum Creek Drive at Rohr Road	Design is underway by a consultant to the Franklin County Engineer's Office. The project will be managed by the County. It includes a widening of Rohr Road between this intersection and Port Road. Stage 1 plans were received and are under review. Construction to begin in 2020.
Bixford Green Trail	Design underway.
Hamilton Rd at Firehouse Lane Intersection Imprvts	Equipment being fabricated. Field work will not begin until late Spring/Summer.
Hendron Ditch Dredging	Work to clean the ditch of sediment substantially complete. Sediment is staged and secured to desiccate until next spring when it will be graded out and seeded in-place south of the ditch.

- **Streets/Street:**

2019 Street Maintenance	Coordinating with the Franklin County Engineer in preparation of project specifications and scope.
E. Bixby Road Improvements	Preparing contract documents for bid solicitation. FCEO will provide construction supervision.
Storm improvements	Design specs being included in Street program, to rehabilitate curb/gutter Bids will determine scope of improvement.

- **Stormwater Program:** Annual report for the City's NPDES MS4 program was prepared and submitted to Ohio EPA.

- **Development projects:**

Traffic Impact Studies	Three difference TIS are under review, submitted by consultants for three potential private development projects.
New High School site	Site stabilization to resume this month
Rickenbacker Central	Site improvements, shoulder and sewer main improvements are substantially complete; punch list are being addressed by the contractor.
Compass (AEP) Data Site	Construction is proceeding.
