1177.08 LIMITATION OF PARKING IN RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICTS.

The provision of parking space, either open or enclosed for the parking or storage of vehicles in a Residential Zoning District or Planned Residential Zoning District as listed in Chapter 1151, shall be subject to the following:

(a) Commercial Vehicles:

- (1) Not more than one truck limited to being a two-axle, four six-tired pickup, panel or light truck, used strictly for commercial purposes, and which has operating characteristics similar to those of a passenger car with a gross vehicle weight (gvw) not exceeding nineteen thousand, five hundred (19,500) pounds shall be allowed per one (1) dwelling unit; said vehicle shall not be permitted on the front yard of any dwelling unit, and are only permitted on the dwelling unit's paved driveway or on a paved surface on the side or rear yard.
- (2) Trucks having dual tires on one (1) or more axles, or having more than two (2) axles, designed for the transportation of cargo, for commercial purposes and including, but not limited to tractor-trucks, trailers and semi-trailers shall not be allowed except in association with a home occupation, subject to approval in accordance with Section 351.17 of the Codified Ordinances and Chapter 1134 Conditional Use Review.
