## **NATIONAL POLICE WEEK NATIONAL PEACE OFFICERS' MEMORIAL DAY**

**Whereas:**

*National Police Week is to honor the service and sacrifice of the law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty while protecting our communities; and*

**WHEREAS:**

*there are approximately 900,000 law enforcement officers serving in communities across the United States, including the dedicated members of the Groveport Police Department; and*

**WHEREAS:**

*in 2020, 295 Peace Officers died in the line of duty nationwide, four of those Peace Officers died in Ohio; and*

**WHEREAS:**

*the names of these dedicated public servants are engraved on the walls of the National Law Enforcement Officers' Memorial in Washington D.C.; and*

**WHEREAS:**

*this administration joins in this special tribute to acknowledge all Ohio officers who have given the supreme sacrifice -their lives- in defense of the citizens of Ohio.*


**NOW, THEREFORE, I, LANCE WESTCAMP, Mayor of the City of Groveport, Ohio, do hereby proclaim:**
