**ACTIVITIES IN PROGRESS**

- Cemetery operations
  - Headstone leveling program will start later this summer or early fall
- Main Street aesthetic enhancements
  - Fire hydrant painting including Storz adapter installation - Completed
  - Street light painting is in progress
    - Eight light poles remain, pending good weather and staff availability
  - Traffic sign replacement program 2021 - Completed
  - Traffic signal painting - Completed
- Mosquito control program
  - Year to date five rounds –
    - June 1<sup>st</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup>
- Professional development
  - Brian Strayer
    - Attended webinars
      - Using Effective Goal Setting, Planning and Control Techniques
      - APWA Pavement Condition Assessment Panel Discussion – Central Ohio Municipalities
  - All Public Works Staff
    - Ohio 811, Ohio Utilities Protection Service representative discussed the importance of utilizing this free service, including the law requiring “Call Before You Dig”
- Sanitary sewer maintenance program
  - June 2021
    - Video inspection – 4,298 feet
    - Line cleaning – 0 feet
- Sidewalk replacement program 2021
  - Harber Concrete is scheduled to start the sidewalk repairs in September
- Street tree maintenance
  - Staff is currently assessing recommendations to create a work list, including pruning and removal
  - Staff has identified locations where street trees are needed to restore consistency throughout the community
