AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE WEST BIXBY ROAD PAVEMENT REHABILITATION (PHASE II) PROJECT

**WHEREAS**, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Groveport is planning to make capital improvements in conjunction with the West Bixby Road Pavement Rehabilitation (Phase II) Project; and,

**WHEREAS**, the above-described infrastructure improvement is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVEPORT, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:**

**Section 1:** That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

**Section 2:** That the City Administrator is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

**Section 3:** That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto which are made a part hereof, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
